

The Rich Fool (Luke 12) | Make-1

This perspective image is a wonderful way of summing up the Parable of the rich fool. One direction shows the delighted farmer with his abundant harvest spilling out from the barns, the other sees the landscape unchanged but instead of a smiling character a sheet covers a shape on the ground.



To make this craft you will need a pair of scissors, a glue stick, and the PDF printout. It can also be helpful to have some double sided tape and a straight edge to fold with.

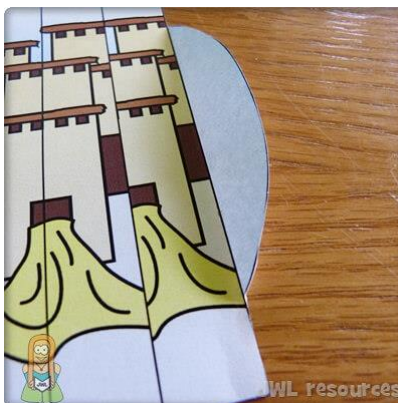
Template:

For printing with colour [PDF](#) – 1 page

For printing with no colour [PDF](#) – 1 page



Cut out your pattern pieces.



Take the image piece and fold the two tabs towards you. this will help you keep track of which way to fold next



Fold the remaining image alternating directions to concertina the paper.



If using double sided tape add 1 or 2 lines to the background.



Stick the round end pieces in place gently allowing the folded edges to catch on the double sided tape (you may have to adjust to get the best results)



View the image from the side to form the new picture.
