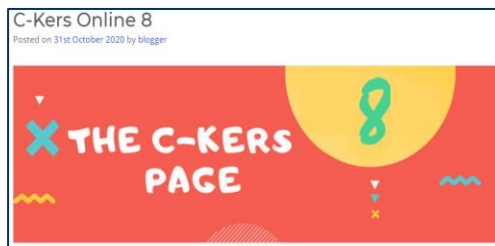

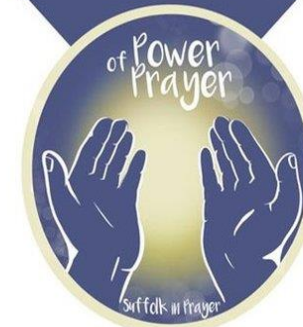
LOCKDOWN AGAIN
