EBA Prayer Focus: Gunton Baptist Church, Lowestoft

Gunton Baptist Church is rooted in the heart of a housing estate just north of Lowestoft, England's most easterly town. The church's location means it is well-suited to its community-focused outlook, with a range of activities designed to support local residents, many of whom live in deprivation. In 'normal' times there is a weekly cafe, craft and toddler groups, a food bank and Roots - a clothing scheme which provides clean, good quality clothing and shoes for those in need. Sunday services are usually held in a relaxed, Café style, and attended by around 30 people but Covid-19 has inevitably led to many of these activities being paused.

Please pray:

- For the elderly who are feeling isolated that they may connected to the wider Church family.
- For energy and refreshing for the leaders of the community work continuing through COVID.
- For guidance for the minister and deacons as they seek to prioritise which activities to restart as the restrictions ease.
