Epping Green Chapel is in the village of Epping Green next to the village pond. The village is in a rural location in the west of Essex on the Hertfordshire border. The current Pastor, Rev Paul Walker, leads the Church along with his wife Jane and a team of Deacons. The village has around 200 inhabitants and is located between the market town of Epping and the new town of Harlow. The Chapel is near a busy road used as a by-pass on the way to London. The Chapel has been holding Zoom meetings during the bad weather but is now holding open air Sunday services in the Chapel car park, unless it rains!! As the chapel is on a main route, cyclists and locals pause or even stop to join in. A real blessing came when some neighbours stopped and responded to a Gospel message: they are now attending the online Alpha course.
