

Prayer Guide 17th July 2022

EBA Prayer Focus: Willingham Baptist Church

Willingham is a large village around twelve miles northwest of Cambridge. The Baptist Church has a fairly small but active congregation, serving the community with a variety of activities including a weekly baby and toddler group, weekly coffee morning, hosting a fortnightly community luncheon club run by the Salvation Army, fortnightly men's and women's groups and monthly men's breakfast. There are also two homegroups which meet fortnightly and weekly Sunday morning and evening services. The church continued to meet weekly online over the Covid-19 lockdowns and came back together in person in September 2021.

Prayer Points:

- For this time of pastoral vacancy, that we would be in tune with the direction that God is leading us as we move forward
- For the next few months as we continue to explore what leading two different expressions of 'church' on a Sunday morning looks like

National & International

- Pray for wisdom for our national leaders and parliamentarians in this time of political crisis.
- Continue to pray for an end to the conflict between Ukraine and Russia
- Pray for the people of Ukraine as they grieve for their country, for loved ones lost and for the loss of their livelihoods. Pray that God will comfort them and sustain them.
- Pray for those fleeing Ukraine, that their paths will be clear. Pray that they will find warm welcomes and safe refuge wherever they go. Pray for Ukrainian families now arriving in Felixstowe.
- Tearfund are reporting of a potential tragedy unfolding in East Africa because of crop failure due to drought. Pray that emergency assistance plans will be put in place.

Town Pastors/Festival Pastors

- Please pray for a safe and spiritually productive time for the Festival Pastors at Latitude on 21st to 24th July
- Pray that more Town Pastors and Base Pray-ers may be raised up to allow them to patrol on more than one Saturday a month.

Felixstowe Carnival

- Pray for Fun and Faith which has family activities and a prayer tent next weekend. Pray that they may have the necessary finances to run it most effectively.

MRBC

- Continue to pray for Walton Parish Nursing: for our Parish Nurses, for the Volunteers, and the activities: Exercise Classes, No Labels, Fizzability. Pray for the clients too.
- Pray that we will know the Lord's presence and guidance as we seek a new Pastor.
- Pray for those experiencing poor health from Covid, Long Covid and other issues. Pray too for those still shielding.
- Do pray for those with health problems during the heatwave this week.
- Pray for the Church Meeting this week that discussion on the Church Profile will be productive

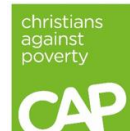
