

EBA Prayer Focus: Nansen Road BC, Ipswich

Nestled in a council housing estate in the south east of Ipswich is Nansen Road Baptist Church. The church is home to a small but growing community of believers who are rooted in serving their neighbours and reaching out to the lost. One of their major outreach activities involves hosting a weekly foodbank, where people can come and purchase a bag of food for £2. The church complements this with the provision of hot drinks and cake, along with the chance for people to sit down and have a chat.

Although this is being paused for the summer, emergency parcels will still be provided where needed. Although the congregation are currently without a minister, they are supported by a moderator, Stu Clarke, who is a retired local minister, and a team of elders and deacons.

Prayer Points:

- That although we are small in number, God will give us the motivation and energy we need as we serve him in this area.
- That we will continue to have opportunities to show God’s love and build relationships with those in the community.
- For our prayer walk in July and for the activities that are planned for the summer, as we reach out to local families.

- Pray for wisdom for our national leaders and parliamentarians in this time of political crisis.
- Continue to pray for an end to the conflict between Ukraine and Russia
- Pray for the people of Ukraine as they grieve for their country, for loved ones lost and for the loss of their livelihoods. Pray that God will comfort them and sustain them.
- Pray for those fleeing Ukraine, that their paths will be clear. Pray that they will find warm welcomes and safe refuge wherever they go. Pray for Ukrainian families now arriving in Felixstowe.

MRBC

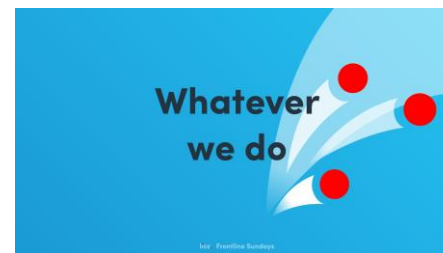
