Neil Kinghorn, the church's minister, says: 'We have not fully opened all ministries since the lockdown, but Tiny Teddies toddler group is running, along with Bible study, prayer meetings and Sunday school. We thank God for four baptisms taking place on July 10.

Prayer focus

- That we may have the opportunity during our toddler group to be witnesses for the Lord Jesus Christ.
- For those being baptised, that they will know the presence and strength of the Lord so they will be able to stand for Jesus.
- For the church, that we may grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge – that we may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.
- Pray that we may know growth in the church spiritually and in people coming to know Jesus.

- Continue to pray for an end to the conflict between Ukraine and Russia
- Pray for the people of Ukraine as they grieve for their country, for loved ones lost and for the loss of their livelihoods. Pray that God will comfort them and sustain them.
- Pray for those fleeing Ukraine, that their paths will be clear. Pray that they will find warm welcomes and safe refuge wherever they go. Pray for Ukrainian families now arriving in Felixstowe.

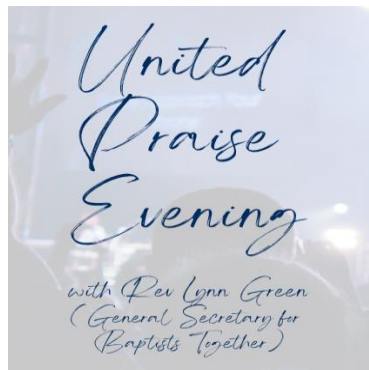
