EBA Prayer Focus: Union Church, Hunstanton

Hunstanton is a traditional seaside resort on the north-west coast of Norfolk. The church first gathered at low tide on the beach between 1850-1870 before permission was granted for the chapel to be built in a prominent location in the town centre. Unusually the church is both a Baptist church and United Reformed church – hence the "union". The church struggled with covid and has taken a long while to reopen. Numbers on Sundays have declined since lockdown but are now beginning to recover with over 35 present last week. The church is currently without a minister but is blessed with a number of talented members who regularly lead services, along with occasional visiting speakers. The congregation is mainly older, reflecting the profile of the town, but everyone is very supportive of the church.

There is a well-attended Friday Fellowship each week as well as regular prayer meetings which are currently held on Zoom. In recent months there has been a whole new deaconate elected and the new leadership team is on a steep learning curve but already rising to the challenges the church faces. Key amongst these are premises and fabric issues with a lot of work that needs to be addressed.

- Pray for the new leadership team as they get to grips with their new roles and the issues to be addressed.
- A solution to the fabric issues with the old buildings which need a lot of work.
- Encouragement for the fellowship as they look forward to the future, seeking a new vision to build the ongoing work and mission of the church.

- Pray for wisdom for our national leaders and parliamentarians in this time of political crisis
- Continue to pray for an end to the conflict between Ukraine and Russia

OPEN DOORS

- Pray that the faith of believers under persecution in parts of India may know God's strength and presence.

- Pray that those who seek to attack and discredit Christians will have their eyes open to the truth of the gospel.
